

## EMOTIONAL SUPPORT ANIMAL (ESA) DOCUMENTATION REQUEST FORM

All USG institutions in on-campus housing the permit ESAs indusing as a reasonable accommodation for residents (students or employees) with disabilities who meet the legal requirements for an ESA under the Fair Housing Act (FHA), 2 U.S.C.A. § 3604(ii), hich is enforced by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

An individual requesting an ASn housing must povide reliable support that shows all the following:

(1) The individual has a physical or mental impairment a record of such an impairment, or is regarded as having such an impairment,

(2) The impairment substantially limits at least one major life activity, and

(3) The individual needs the specific animal requested because it performs a job or task, provides assistance, or performs at least one task that benefits the person because of his or her disability, or because the animal provides therapeutic emotional sup**poattle**viate a symptom or effect of the disability of the individual.

\*AnESAaccommodations limited to one animal unless specific justification is provided to support the necessity of more than one animal.

\*\*This form should be ompleted by a medical professional or reliable third party such as a therapist, who is in a position to know about the student disability. \*\*
