## Sport Programs Graduate Assistant

The Sport Programs Graduate Assistant shall maintain a role in overseeing student employees, coordinating sports leagues and mentoring/advising select Club Sports. Candidates should strive to develop and progress the comprehensive intramural Sports program and Club Sports program. The position will uphold the Department of Sports and Recreation mission, vision, and values throughout work and participation in programs.

## Preferred Qualifications

Two years of collegiate recreation program experience, CPR/First Aid Instructor certification, experience utilizing Fusion and/or other recreation management software, MLeagues, and/or Connect2 software, ability to work with a diverse group, career aspirations in recreational sports, motivated, enthusiastic and attentive to detail.

## Stipend and Waiver

To receive a final offer, candidates must be accepted to a Graduate Program at Kennesaw State University and have an approved Tuition Waiver. Candidates must be a full-time student in a two-year graduate program. This program carries a full tuition waiver (in-state or out-of-state). This appointment will begin August 2024 and conclude in May 2025, second year is contingent on academic and job performance. The position will be paid \$18.75/hour and will be expected to work 20 hours per week, including days, nights, and weekends. Student fees, school application fees, and other expenses will be the individual filling this position's responsibility.
